Stage I: Screening

All application submissions undergo an initial screening to check that all required fields are completed, and that the applicant meets all eligibility criteria.

Stage II: Interview

If the applicant meets eligibility criteria, a qualified representative will attempt to contact the applicant and schedule a telephone interview. If after three attempts by email, telephone, fax, and/or post-marked mail no contact is able to be made, the application may be disqualified; however, the applicant may reapply.

The interview ranges from 20 to 30 minutes to address factors regarding symptoms, treatment history, motivation, willingness, financial need, and medical necessity. The information collected will be used to make suggestions to the Clinical Board of Directors regarding eligibility and recommended level of care. We encourage the applicant to ask questions during this stage. The level of care recommendation will be based on applicant's medical necessity as determined by applicant's current physician or therapist. The applicant and guardian (if appropriate) must sign the consent form, disclosure of information or other required waivers. The Clinical Board of Directors may request additional information on a case-by-case basis.



Stage III: Determination

Following the initial interview, the Clinical Board of Directors will review the interviewer notes and supporting professionals' recommendations to reach a decision considering acceptance, award, and placement. Once a decision has been rendered, a foundation representative will make reasonable attempts to notify the applicant via phone call, email, fax, and/or post-marked mail.

Stage IV: Awarded Funds

After applicant's confirmation to continue the process, the applicant's information is voted on by the Board of Directors at the quarterly Board of Directors Meeting. Scholarship award amounts will be based on available funds and the estimated cost of recommended treatment. Funds will be released to the applicant's account at the selected treatment providers.

Stage V: Requirements once Granted Scholarship

Applicant is required to attend all scheduled appointments with selected treatment provider. If applicant is awarded scholarship for a treatment programs, applicant must stay for the initial agreed upon treatment period. Failure to attend scheduled appointments or leaving a treatment center early may result in applicant's disqualification for continued awarded scholarship funds, reimbursement of funds already distributed and/or future assistance from Rebecca's Eating Disorder Foundation.

Because we know that early recovery needs support after treatment, the applicant agrees to attend local support meetings as suggested by the aftercare treatment plan.
